

IMPROVING FACIAL STRUCTURE TO NORMALIZE FUNCTION

As such, attendees will learn treatment methods that are forward thinking, including Dr. Lipskis' process of treatment to idealize facial structures to provide more optimal function. The earlier the problems are addressed, the more impactful the outcome.

Dr Lipskis embarked upon a 30+ year journey and over 2500 hours of post graduate continuing education in the areas of facial development; orthodontics; facial orthopedics; craniofacial pain; and sleep medicine. Dr. Lipskis has been invited to lecture with Dr. Derek Mahony, Dr. Steven Olmos, Dr. Kevin Boyd, and many other organizations. In 2009, Dr. Lipskis was awarded a Fellowship and Diplomate status by the American Board of Craniofacial Pain (ABCP). He was granted Diplomate status in Sleep Dentistry in 2013. 

CASE PRESENTATION OF VERY CHALLENGING AND COMPLEX CASES

Description: The speaker will be presenting numerous interesting, challenging and complex cases. Many of them were verbalized and published in the International Journal of Orthodontics and Spectrum Ortho. The presented cases will entail a melange of TM dysfunction treatment - after the therapeutic position was crystalized, tooth transposition cases, cases treated with the assistance of Temporary Anchorage Device (TAD, Miniscrew) and extraction cases. The presenter will also introduce the audience to the Micro osteo-perforation (MOP) technique. Following the conclusion of this presentation the attendees will have learned the principles and the protocol for stable finishing of patients with TM dysfunction, as well as indication and contraindications for the last resort of orthodontic treatment – extraction of permanent teeth. They also will have learned the indications and placement techniques of TADs and the advantages of accelerated orthodontic treatment with the assistance of the Micro osteo-perforation technique.

Dr. Adrian J. Palencar graduated from Komensky University in Bratislava, Slovakia, with the degree Doctor of Universal Medicine, and a specialty in Stomatology. He was recertified at Western University, Ontario, Canada in 1970. Dr. Palencar is Master of the AGD, Diplomate of the IBO, Fellow of the Academy of Dentistry International, Fellow of the Pierre Fouchard Academy and a Fellow of the International College of Dentists. Dr. Palencar received his Pinsker Award in 2003 and an Award for authoring the most outstanding article published in the IJO in 2015.
