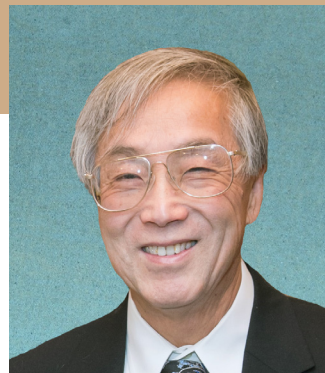

OVERCOMING A MULTITUDE OF ISSUES FROM MAXILLARY UNDERDEVELOPMENT

Description: This course will bring together the advantages of Orthodontics as well as methods in General Dentistry, as they often collide back and forth in TMD treatment plans of the underdeveloped Maxilla. This course will have examples of cases treated, along with details on how to overcome obstacles that complex TMD cases present. New ideas in bite opening of the deep bite and how to surgically locate and treat impacted canine retrievals using traditional ortho with more efficient methods.

- Problem-solving multiple different treatment plans for issues related to the underdeveloped Maxilla
- Utilizing new techniques in retrieving impacted canines
- Learning how to do in-house simple Ortho lab work, saving thousands of dollars each year

IT'S NOT OVER TILL IT'S OVER – FORWARD FACIAL GROWTH ENABLING STRAIGHTWIRE MECHANOTHERAPY

Description: This course displays a technique based on over 25 years of attending and video reviewing orthodontic CE at the local and national levels at approximately 80 credits per year. The lecturer has contracted speakers for the IAO New England for close to 20 years and has made it a point to incorporate elements from many of the presented techniques to develop this treatment philosophy, which has recently gained much publicity with the Dr. John & Mike Mew Article in The New York Times Aug. 20, 2020. The approach is based on over 20 years of photographically documented cases and case follow-ups.

- Mandibular non-surgical Advancement

H. Michael Sefranek DMD, MAGD completed his DMD degree at the University of Connecticut in 1989. The presenter has lectured on orthodontics at New York University School of Dentistry (where he completed a two-year continuing education program in orthodontics), the New York County Dental Society, the Rhode Island AGD (Academy of General Dentistry), the International Association for Orthodontics (IAO) national meeting, and IAO New England (where he has taught the Advanced in-house Seminar Series of 10 lectures spanning 2 years). He is past president of the IAO New England, past president of the Rhode Island AGD, as well as past president of New England Mastertrack. EARLY ORTHODONTIC TREATMENT: “WHAT, WHY, WHEN, AND HOW TO TREAT”

Description: Every day, dentists face the dilemma of being able to recognize early childhood growth and developmental problems, and to decide when and what treatment options are best for their patients. This course will discuss the importance of diagnosing airway problems, crossbites, Class IIIs, deep bites, crowding, and habits, and their effects on the development of the oral-cranio-facial complex. Timing and various treatment modalities for these issues will be reviewed.





Upon completion, participants will have gained an understanding on:

- The importance of taking good records to establish a comprehensive diagnosis
- The importance of early treatment for airway problems, habits, Class III's, crossbites, crowded arches, and deep bites
- The significant impact that airway problems can have on the growth and development in children
- How to correct deep bites in children using composite build ups, preserve arch length, and correct cross bites

After graduating from the University of Pennsylvania SDM in 1979 and completing a general practice residency program, Dr. DiSanto-Rose and his family moved back to the Adirondack Mountains in upstate New York where he began his general dental practice in Johnstown, NY.

He is a Fellow in both the Academy of General Dentistry (AGD) and the International Association for Orthodontics (IAO). In 1987, he received a certificate of completion from Long Island University for orthodontic studies. He continued his orthodontic training and became a member of the New England Chapter of the IAO in 1989. He received the IAO Fellowship Award in 1997, and completed the IAO Instructor's Institute in 2010, receiving his Senior Instructor's Certification. Since his membership in the IAO, he has earned over 3000 credit hours in orthodontic studies and has remained an active member in the New England Chapter where he has been an instructor since 2006. AIRWAY, BREATHING AND SLEEP: ORTHODONTIC PERSPECTIVES

Description: The aim of this course is to visit various topics associated with clinical growth and development of the upper airway and discuss the potential impact of craniofacial orthodontics on the upper airway, breathing and sleep.

SIGNIFICANCE OF TM JOINT IN ORTHODONTICS, TMD, AND OSA DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT

Description: Orthodontics, TMD, and OSA diagnosis treatment failed because the TM Joint was not considered. The treatment protocol is to treat the cause of the problems and not just treating the symptoms. Occlusion and Oral facial Dysfunctions are best defined as dysfunction of the Teeth-Muscles-Jaw joint complex.

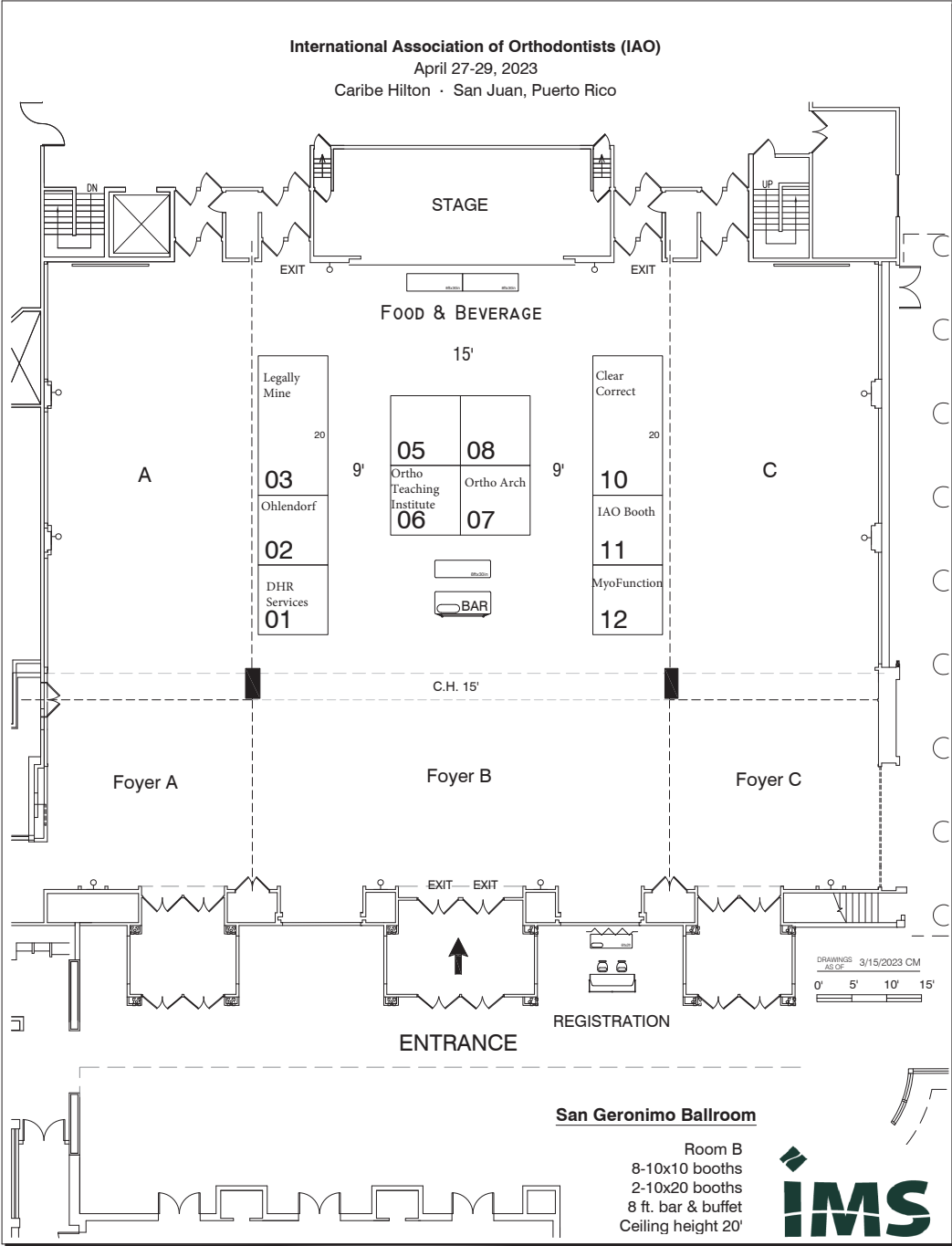
